## Peace Journalism Laboratory Privacy Policy

#### What data do we collect?

Peace Journalism Lab collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Name, email address, phone number, etc.)

#### How do we collect your data?

You directly provide PJJ with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Voluntarily complete an application form for our program
- PJJ may also receive your data indirectly from partners in our programs

#### How will we use your data?

PJJ collects your data so that we can:

- Process with your application
- Email you regarding new programs

#### How do we store your data?

- PJJ securely stores your data at our database at external hard drives.
- PJJ will keep your [application] for [2 years]. Once this period has expired, we will delete your data.

#### Newsletters

- PJJ would like to send you information about our programs, articles etc. of ours that we think you might like.
- You have the right at any time to stop PJJ from contacting you by sending an email.

#### What is your data protection rights?

PJJ would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

- **The right to access** - You have the right to request PJJ for copies of your personal data.
- **The right to rectification** - You have the right to request that PJJ correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request PJJ to complete information you believe is incomplete.
- **The right to erasure** - You have the right to request that PJJ erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to restrict processing** - You have the right to request that PJJ restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to object to processing** - You have the right to object to PJJ's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to data portability** - You have the right to request that PJJ transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
