Current issues concerning Forensic Medicine and Forensic Psychiatry will be presented during the “3rd Conference on Forensic Medicine and Forensic Psychiatry,” which will take place from Friday, 22 May to Saturday, 23 May 2026, from 09:00 to 21:00, at the Porto Palace Hotel in Thessaloniki.

The Conference aims to address pressing issues affecting contemporary society that often raise concerns regarding their management and handling. Physicians from various specialties, legal professionals, members of the judiciary, psychologists, social workers, and representatives of law enforcement agencies will participate in the Conference proceedings.

This year’s event forms part of an ongoing effort to enhance continuing education by focusing on modern and critical issues related to everyday forensic medicine, forensic psychiatry, clinical, and judicial practice.

Conference thematic sessions include, among others: **“Suicidality in Minors and Management Strategies,” “Stalking,” “Child Forensic Psychiatry – Involuntary Hospitalization of Minors,” “Juvenile Delinquency and Educational Management,” “Mobbing,” “ADHD and Criminality,” “Delinquency and the Migration Issue,” “Sexual Offenders: Psychopathology and Crime,” “Domestic Violence: Holistic Approach, Prevention and Support,” “Transgender Individuals and Abuse,” “Criminal Liability of Physicians/Midwives in Cases of Perinatal Asphyxia,” “Veterinary Forensics: Legislative Framework and Procedures,” “Postpartum Mental Disorders and the Role of the Midwife,” “Chemsex and Delinquency,” “Artificial Intelligence in Forensic Sciences,” and “The Role of Healthcare Professionals in Perpetrators and Victims of Crimes Against Life.”**

The Conference takes place within the framework of the Postgraduate Program of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki entitled “Forensic Medicine – Forensic Psychiatry” and operates under the auspices of the Aristotle University, the Faculty of Health Sciences, and the School of Medicine.
