**Conference on the War Economy by Aristotle University and the
Supreme Joint War College: Focus on the Russo-Ukrainian Conflict**

Thessaloniki, 19/1/2026

“The War Economy” is the theme of the Conference organized by the Faculty of Law of Aristotle University and the Supreme Joint War College (A.DI.S.PO.), on Thursday 22 and Friday 23 January 2026, at the Ceremonial Hall of Aristotle University. The Conference will open on Thursday, 22 January 2026, at 9:00 a.m.

“This is an extremely timely topic, examined for the first time in Greece,” the organizers note, adding: “The Conference will initially examine the efforts of a country’s economy during wartime to meet the demands of war. It will also address the challenges faced by the economy of a country preparing for war, which for this purpose is called upon to develop its defense industry.” The Russo-Ukrainian conflict will serve as a reference case at the Conference for all involved and interested countries.

“The topic is approached from all its critical aspects, which also emerged during the Russo-Ukrainian conflict and largely determined its course,” the organizers emphasize.

More specifically, the Conference will examine:

- The fiscal and macroeconomic issues that arise in the states involved,
- The complex problems resulting from the imposition of sanctions, both for the countries subjected to them and for the countries that impose them,
- International cooperation aimed at strengthening a country’s security,
- The protection of energy and critical infrastructure, which constitute preferred targets of belligerents and directly affect their economies, if not the outcome of the war itself,
- The development of a dual-use defense industry in peacetime.
