## Linguistics in the Age of Artificial Intelligence: Conference at Aristotle University on the Language Sciences in the 21st Century

Thessaloniki, 12 November 2025

The School of French Language and Literature at Aristotle University is organizing a Conference titled "Language Sciences in the 21st Century" on Thursday, 20 November 2025, from 8:45 to 20:00, at the Amphitheater of the Central Library.

The Conference takes place as part of the celebrations marking 100 years since the founding and operation of Aristotle University and 70 years since the establishment of the School of French Language and Literature.

According to the organizers, the aim of the Conference is to highlight the challenges and perspectives of language sciences within a fluid and changing landscape of crisis and reconfiguration in the humanities, with a particular focus on the Greek context.

During the Conference, participants will explore topics such as Computational Linguistics, Natural Language Processing, Artificial Intelligence, language teaching and learning through digital tools, new methods and approaches to language education in a globalized environment, linguistic inequalities in digital communication, the commodification of linguistic practices, and language and social justice. Thirteen distinguished speakers from Greek universities will participate in the event.

The Conference addresses linguists, faculty members, teaching staff, undergraduate and postgraduate students, PhD candidates in Schools of Philology and Foreign Languages, as well as researchers in the humanities, political, and social sciences.
