**Significant Donation of Equipment to the Student Dormitories of the
Aristotle University**

Thessaloniki, 24/2/2026

A significant boost to improving the living conditions of students at the Aristotle University comes through the donation of modern equipment from HELLENIQ ENERGY to the University's Student Dormitories.

The donation, with a total budget of €48,351 plus VAT, includes the supply of 150 single beds with corresponding mattresses, 100 desks with metal legs, 200 chairs suitable for these desks, and 100 double-door wardrobes. The equipment was selected based on the needs of the four dormitory buildings to fully meet the functional requirements of the premises.

The handover ceremony took place on Wednesday, 11 February 2026, in the University's Senate Hall, in the presence of the Rector, Professor Kyriakos Anastasiadis, the Vice-Rectors, Professor Nikolaos Maggioros and Professor Iakovos Michailidis, the CEO of HELLENIQ ENERGY, Andreas Siamisiis, as well as the President of the Youth and Lifelong Learning Foundation, Anna Rokofyllou.

The Student Dormitories of the Aristotle University accommodate approximately 1,500 students. This company initiative aims to upgrade the daily lives of residents, with an emphasis on safety, dignity, and the functionality of the living spaces.

In his statement, the Rector of the Aristotle University, Professor Kyriakos Anastasiadis, described the donation as "a substantial act of social responsibility and tangible support for public higher education," noting that the upgrade of the Dormitories significantly improves the living conditions of hundreds of students. At the same time, he warmly thanked the management of HELLENIQ ENERGY for their

cooperation and sensitivity, as well as all those who contributed to the implementation of the initiative.

In his statement, the CEO of HELLENIQ ENERGY, Andreas Siamisiis, said: “HELLENIQ ENERGY consistently supports public higher education, which constitutes a foundation of progress for the country. Our donation to the Aristotle University aims at the immediate improvement of the daily lives of those residing in the Dormitories. Our goal is for these upgraded spaces to serve as an additional incentive for our students to devote themselves fully to their studies without distraction. On our part, we will continue to stand by them through initiatives such as scholarship and awards programs, which have now been established as an institution.”

Speaking at the equipment handover ceremony, the President of the Youth and Lifelong Learning Foundation, Anna Rokofyllou, noted: “Upgrading student welfare is a priority for INEDIVIM. I would like to thank HELLENIQ ENERGY, which clearly demonstrates the social sensitivity and responsibility that characterize it, as it responded immediately to our request and proceeded with a significant donation for the modernization of the Thessaloniki Student Dormitories (FETH). As the administration of INEDIVIM, we have launched a substantial program of interventions in student dormitories nationwide. In particular, at FETH, we transformed what was essentially an abandoned space into a state-of-the-art common room and multipurpose activity center, where students will be able to spend their free time in an aesthetically pleasing, modern, and functional environment. We will continue consistently along this path in the future, ensuring all the necessary conditions so that the new generation of our country can shape its own future without distraction.”
